

VISIT TO ROUSHAM HOUSE AND GARDENS, NEAR BICESTER

WEDNESDAY, 5th JUNE 2024

Dear Members,

We are delighted to plan a visit to Rousham House and Gardens. This country house, built in 1635, has been in the continuous ownership of the Cottrell-Dormer family. It was remodelled by Kent in the 18th century in a free Gothic style and contains fine collections of Jacobean and 18th century furniture, paintings and statuary.

One of England's most important gardens, Rousham represents the first phase of English landscape design and remains almost as its designer William Kent left it. Monty Don says "Kent is the great genius of eighteenth-century garden design and Rousham is his masterpiece, one of the greatest gardens in the world". Don't miss the walled garden with its herbaceous borders, small parterre, pigeon house and espaliers.
